KS2

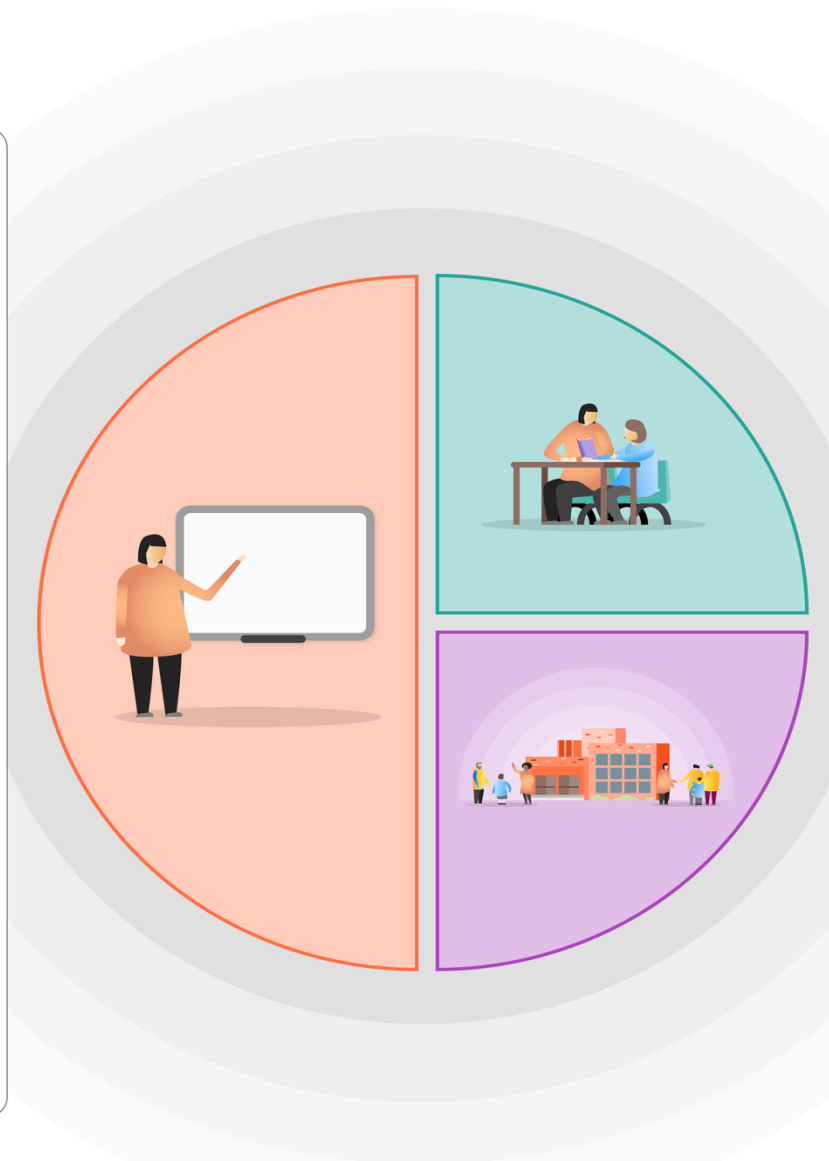
Y6 – ensure securing of fractions/decimals from Y5 curriculum rapidly.

Additional phonics revision of sounds/patterns from previous year as whole class intervention + on track teaching.

Closer matching of reading books to phonics phase and ability of pupils. More strategic approach to choosing of books. Investment in books and info to parents.

Additional daily teaching from Sendco in Y6.

GDS pupils to be assessed rapidly and be provided with appropriate extension work.

Daily reading for identified pupils with TAs – training provided.

Reading interventions KS2 as after school booster sessions (HLTA/Teachers spring)

Maths interventions KS2 as after school booster sessions (HLTA/Teachers spring/summer).
